AIRPORT/GROUND TRANSPORTATION

San Antonio International Airport is serviced by most domestic carriers and international carriers. The airport is located approximately 15 minutes from the Riverwalk and Downtown. Taxis are available at each terminal in the airport. Rental car agencies are also available at the airport.
